Sirumalai village and runs towards east direction alongwith the southern boundary line of S.Nos. 558, 561, 577 and meets at the quadra junction point S.Nos. 561, 577 of village No. 37. Ambadurai village, Sirumalai Northwest Slope Reserved Forest No. 3 (notified as Reserved Forest in Notification No. 31, dated 15th January 1900) and S.No. 695 part of village No. 93 Sirumalai Village. Thence, this boundary runs towards east along with the southern boundary line of Sirumalai north west Slope Reserved Forest No. 3 (notified as Reserved Forest in Notification No. 31, dated 15th January 1900) and S.No. 364 and meets at the tri-junction point of S.Nos. 364, 365 and 695 part of village No. 93. Sirumalai village.

Right No.1: Channel

There is a channel situated in S.No. 760/2 of Sirumalai village in an extent of 8.32.5 hectares at the northern upper side within the four boundaries of the proposed Sirumalai west Forest Block-I Bit-I. This is a separate survey field. This channel originates at the boundary of S.Nos. 695 and 760-2 of Sirumalai village within the forest area. The breadth of the Channel at the Eastern edge is 131 meter. This channel runs westwards and southwards and ends at the boundary of S.Nos. 695 and 760-2 of Sirumalai village. The breadth of the channel at the southern edge is 49.4 meter. This channel originates as Odai from S.No. 695, gets converted into channel in S.No. 760-2 and then reconverted into Odai in S.No. 695 and passes westwards and then ends near Sirumalaiyaru Reservoir after crossing S.No. 452 of village No. 37. Oruthattu village. This channel has been in existence even prior to the preliminary notification under Section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Forest Act, 1882. Therefore, permission has been granted to the existing channel without any deviation in its direction and the public were permitted to use the existing channel in its direction in *suo-moto* claim No .589/2009, dated 30th June 2009 of the Forest Settlement Officer, Dindigul.

These three temples are situated at a distance of 1.0 Km. northwestern side of Agasthiarpuram hamlet of Sirumalai village. They have been in existence even before the publication of preliminary notification under Section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Forest Act, 1882. The public from the hamlet villages of Sirumalai village and the public of Rajathanikottai hamlet of Oruthattu village use to these three temples through the pathway situated in the proposed Sirumalai West Forest Block-I Bit-I to worship the Gods therein. Therefore, right to the public to worship the Gods, these three temples and right to use the

pathway to the public have been permitted in *suo-moto* claim No. 591/2009, dated 30th June 2009 of the Forest Settlement Officer, Dindigul. This pathway originates in the boundary of S.No. 391 of Oruthattu village and 760/1 of Sirumalai village, runs towards northwest direction in S.No. 760/1 classified as mountain, enters into S.No. 695 classified as Forest, further travels in the northeast direction and ends in the boundary of S.Nos. 759 and 695 of Sirumalai village. The length of this pathway is 8275 meters with breadth of 1 meter.

No. II(2)/HOU/150/2010—In exercise of powers conferred by Section 113 of the Tamil Nadu Town and Country Planning Act, 1971 (Tamil Nadu Act 35 of 1972), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby exempts the site at S.Nos. 3171/7, 3171/A, 3171/8, Block No. 59, Triplicane Village, Anna Salai, Jagajeevanram Road (Wallajah Road), Swami Sivananda Salai (Adams Road), Chennai, from the item 1(c) of Annexure XX, referred to in sub-regulation (8) of Regulation 28 of Development Regulations of Second Master Plan for Chennai Metropolitan Area 2026 relating to reservation of land for communal and recreational purposes for the proposed construction of Assembly Building-Ground Floor+6 Floors; Secretariat Building-Ground Floor+7 Floors; Assembly Building and Secretariat Building-Connecting Block-Ground Floor; Guest House-Ground Floor+3 Floors; Rajaji Hall-Ground Floor+2 Floors; Parking Block-Ground Floor+5 Floors+ Parking at Terrace; Security Block-Ground Floor; Kalaivanar Arangam-Ground Floor+2 Floors; Parking Block-Ground Floor+2 Floors; Sub-Station, Gen set and STP by the Executive Engineer, Public Works Department Chennai-5, subject to the condition that the applicant shall maintain the Open Space Reservation area earmarked only as park and play field and not for any other purpose and any violation in this regard shall be dealt with by the Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority appropriately.
